The sculptors create their masterpieces in stages and later assemble the whole set to form the garbhagruha. After the dry run of assembly, it would be dismantled and shipped to Plano, Texas for a reassembly at the temple.

We are happy to state that Sri Ganesha Garbhagruha or sannidhi in our temple would be the most impressive one in modern times still following the traditions of building the temple in all granite.
